(1) Heard on I.A.No.01, application for condonation of delay under Section 5 of the Limitation Act in filing the civil revision.

(2) On due consideration, I am satisfied that the applicant has succeeded in explaining the cause of delay in filing the civil revision and, therefore, I.A. No.01 is allowed. Delay in filing the civil revision is hereby condoned.
