ORAL ORDER :

4. Considering the fact that short-term sentences are awarded to the present applicants and that those are already suspended by the learned Sessions Judge for a limited period, the substantive sentences are hereby suspended till disposal of the respective criminal appeals.

5. The fine amount has been already deposited by the present applicants. Both the present applicants be released on bail on their executing P.R. bond in the sum of Rs. 15,000/- (rupees fifteen thousand) each and also upon furnishing surety each in the like amount.

6. Both the applications are accordingly allowed and disposed of.
