2] Learned counsel for the petitioners undertakes to deposit the deficit court fees in all the petitions within a period of one week from today.

3] The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the Respondent/State jointly submit that, the issue raised in these petitions is no longer *res integra*. This Court in similar fact situation has considered the issue in Writ Petition No.8461 of 2014 (Shiva Trust's Aurangabad Nursing School V/s The State of Maharashtra and others) and directed the Respondent/State to release the tuition fees/examination fees of the students of the petitioners - schools for the reserved category students of ANM/GNM course for the academic year 2011-2012 and 2012-2013.

4] For the same reasons, which are assigned in the said order, we direct the Respondent/State to release the tuition fees/examination fees of the students of the petitioners - Schools for the reserved category students of ANM/GNM course for the academic year 2011-

2012, as expeditiously as possible, however, preferably within three months from today. However, we make it clear that, the respondent/State will be entitled to make the scrutiny/examine the necessary requirements.

5] The Petitions stand disposed of in the above terms.
