ORDER:

. When the present appeals are taken up for hearing, Shri Munde, learned counsel for the Claimants in both the matters, submitted that the claim petitions filed under Section 166 of the Act arising out of the same accident have been finally decided by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Latur. Admittedly, the present appeals are arising out of NFL order passed in two matters arising out

of the same accident.
