2] The learned Counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that the petition can be conveniently disposed of in the light of the averments made in paragraphs 9 and 10 of the affidavit-in-reply filed by respondent no.4.

3] Upon perusal of paragraphs 9 and 10 of the affidavit-in-reply of respondent no.4, it appears that the respondent/authority has sanctioned two divisions for each standards i.e. 11<sup>th</sup> standard and 12<sup>th</sup> standard. One division is on grant-in-aid basis and another on non-grant basis. It is further stated in paragraph 10 of the affidavit-
