**ORDER :**

- 1] The petitioner shall satisfy the Taxing Officer.
- 2] This petition can be disposed of by issuing directions to the respondents to take decision on the application tendered by the petitioners u/s 28-A of the Land Acquisition Act as expeditiously as possible and preferably within a period of six months from today, and it is accordingly directed.
