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PER COURT :-

- 1) Heard the learned Counsel for applicant and learned counsel for original claimant. Delay of 77 days has occurred in filing the present appeal by the Insurance Company.
- 2) Learned Counsel appearing for the original claimant has opposed for condoning the delay, stating that the reasons assigned are insufficient.
- 3) For the reasons stated in the application, which according to me are just and sufficient, the delay caused in filing the appeal stand condoned.
- 4) The appeals be registered in accordance
