2. On perusal of application Exh.86, it is noted that dispensation of personal appearance of the petitioners – accused nos.2, 3, 6 and 8 was sought for.

2. In Sessions Case No.232 of 2010, learned Sessions Judge rejected the application of the petitioners for exemption (Exh.86), on the ground that no sufficient ground for absence was shown and issued non-bailable warrant against them.
