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PER COURT :-

1) The applicant/petitioner has filed this application seeking permission to serve the Respondents by way of paper publication. It is submitted that the addresses which are mentioned of all these respondents in the petition are based on the addresses of the said respondents in the proceedings before the lower court. It is further submitted that the notices issued to the respondents on the said addresses have returned unserved on the ground that the respondents are not residing on the given addresses.
