2. Prima facie, it appears that the findings
recorded by the Court below are in consonance with
the evidence brought on record, in as much as the
Trial Court relied upon the evidence of three eye
witnesses coupled with the medical evidence.

Therefore, no case is made out for grant of bail. The applicant was not on bail during trial. Hence, the Application stands rejected.
