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PER COURT :-

1) Heard. Delay of 684 days has occurred in filing the appeals. The learned counsel appearing for the respondents/claimants does not have any objection for condoning the delay. 2) On registration of the appeal, issue notice to respondents. Learned Counsel waives service for the respondent/s.
