2 Learned APP waives service of notice for Respondent / State.

3 Heard the learned counsel for parties. Perused report of Investigating Officer dated 5th May, 2016.

4 It is stated in said report that during investigation supplementary statements of witnesses came to be recorded and on the basis of supplementary statements investigating agency could not find *prima-facie* involvement of Applicants in commission of crime.

5 In view of the above this Court is inclined to enlarge the Applicants on bail. Hence the following order –

ORDER

- I. Criminal Application No.2506 of 2016 is allowed.
- II. Applicants are released on bail in Crime No.17 of 2016 registered at Dindrud Police Station, District Beed for the offences punishable under Sections 295-A, 427 and 143 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3(1)(X) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act on P.R. and S.B. of Rs.15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand Only) each.
- III. Applicants shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence and shall make themselves available as and when required for investigation.
- IV. Bail before the Trial Court.
