ORAL ORDER :-

. Heard Mr. Sachin S.Deshmukh, learned counsel appearing for the applicant.

2. The applicant has been convicted for the offence punishable u/s 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 and is sentenced to suffer Simple Imprisonment for a period of one month and to pay fine of Rs. 1 Lakh. The sentence imposed by the criminal Court has been confirmed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, against which the present

application is preferred.

3. During the pendency of Criminal Appeal, the applicant has already deposited an amount of Rs. 30,000/- [Rupees Thirty Thousand] before the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Latur. Mr. Deshmukh, learned counsel appearing for the applicant has stated that now the applicant is ready to deposit additional amount of Rs. 20,000/- [Rupees Twenty Thousand].

4. Hence, in view of the facts and the submissions made on behalf of the applicant, the applicant Meera w/o Dayanand Shinde be released on bail on her furnishing P.R. Bond of Rs. 15,000/- [Rupees Fifteen Thousand] with one surety in the like amount till the disposal of the Criminal Revision Application subject to the condition that the applicant should deposit an amount of Rs. 20,000/- [Rupees Twenty Thousand] before the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Latur within a period of one week from today.

5. Criminal Revision Application is '**admitted**'.

6. Criminal Application stands disposed of. Authenticated copy of this order be given to the parties.
