ORAL ORDER :

Learned Magistrate awarded monthly maintenance of Rs.600/- per month to the respondent-wife, by an order dated 28/11/2002, pursuant to the provisions of Section 125 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, revision against which was dismissed by learned Sessions Judge. This Court ordered payment of maintenance @ Rs.200/- per month while granting interim protection in favour of the present petitioner.

2. Present writ petition can be conveniently disposed of, with following observations.

That the petitioner shall continue to pay Rs.600/- (Rs. Six hundred only) per month towards maintenance as ordered by learned Magistrate, with effect from 01/01/2015, provided that the order of payment of maintenance was not modified under Section 127 of the Code of Criminal Procedure by the subordinate Court.

3. Criminal Writ Petition stands disposed of in above terms.
