1 It had transpired on 09.12.2016 that if Respondent Nos.2, 5 and 6 pay a lump-sum amount of Rs.1,25,000/- towards unpaid wages, the Petitioner would seek disposal of this Contempt Petition.

2 The learned Advocate for Respondent Nos.2, 5 and 6 has tendered the cheque dated 09.12.2016 in the name of the Petitioner for an amount of Rs.1,25,000/- (Rupees One Lac Twenty Five Thousand). The photocopy of the cheque is taken on record and the cheque is handed over to the learned Advocate for the Petitioner.

3 The learned Advocate for the Petitioner accepts the cheque and submits, on instructions, that since there is compliance of the order at issue, the Petitioner is satisfied and this Contempt Petition can, therefore, be disposed of.
