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PER COURT :-

- 1) In view of availability of alternate remedy for redressal of the grievances of the petitioner under Section 9(1)(b) of The Maharashtra Employees of Private Schools (Conditions of Service) Regulation Act, 1977, the instant petition need not be entertained. Keeping option of the petitioner to avail of alternate remedy open, the petitioner is permitted to withdraw the petition.
