2] The record would show that on the basis of the material on record, the learned Special Judge has held that the present petitioner cannot be discharged.

3] The material on record would show that after marriage of the present petitioner with the

principal accused, the property came to be purchased. The explanation, if any, of the petitioner regarding the source of funds including certain oral transaction, is required to be examined on merit by the learned Special Judge.

4] In the circumstances, no case on merit is made out in the present petition. The Criminal Writ Petition is, therefore, dismissed.
