Order :-

1. Heard Mr. Kale, learned counsel for the applicant, learned Assistant Government Pleader for respondents No.1 to 3 and Mr. Shah, learned counsel for respondent Municipal Corporation.
2. Learned counsel for the applicants submits that applicant No. 2 is not in position to remain present before the Registrar of this Court for verification of undertaking.
