1. None present for the appellants.
2. Learned counsel for respondent No.3-acquiring body submits that execution petition in respect of land acquisition reference bearing LAR No. 218 of 2011 (Waman s/o Durgaji Gore v/s. The State of Maharashtra) and LAR No. 219 of 2011 (Bhagwan s/o Vishwanath Sajan v/s. The State of Maharashtra) are amicably settled before the Lok Nyayalaya on 11.04.2015 at Parbhani, and accordingly, the present appellants/claimants have even accepted enhanced amount of compensation and accordingly the execution petitions came to be disposed of as satisfied. Learned counsel, in order to substantiate his contention, placed a copy of said settlement before this Court, which is taken on record and marked "X" for

identification in both these appeals.
