Per Court:

1 The Applicant points out that this Court by its order dated 19.01.2015 delivered in Writ Petition No.4032/2014 had permitted the Respondent/ Employee to withdraw the amount deposited by the Petitioner in the Court subject to the condition that the Respondent/ Employee executes an indemnity bond to the satisfaction of the Registrar (Judicial) of the same amount.

2 The contention is that an inappropriate/ insufficient indemnity bond has been filed.

3 I find that this Court has observed in paragraph 10 of the order dated 19.01.2015 as under:-

“10. The respondent-employee is permitted to withdraw the amount deposited by the petitioner in this Court, subject to condition that the respondent-employee executes the indemnity bond to the satisfaction of the Registrar (Judicial) of the same amount.”

4 Shri Bhadgaonkar, learned Advocate for the Employee, relies on his affidavit in reply and submits that he has executed the indemnity bond on Rs.100/- non judicial stamp paper. In the event, it is required that the said bond should be on Rs.200/- non judicial stamp paper, he is willing to furnish such bond.

5 Considering the contentions of the parties, I do not think that this Civil Application needs to be kept pending. The same is, therefore, disposed of with a direction that the Applicant and the Non-Applicant shall, either in person or through their Advocates, approach the Registrar (Judicial), Bombay High Court, Aurangabad on 10.02.2016 at about 2:30 pm. The Registrar (Judicial) shall look into the grievance of the parties and in the event, the bond is to be furnished on Rs.200/- non judicial stamp paper, he shall issue necessary direction to the Non Applicant.
