2. Learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Pathardi, by an order dated 25th November, 2009, passed in Criminal Misc. Application No.208 of 2008, directed the petitioner to pay enhanced maintenance of Rs.1,500/- per month each to respondents no.2 & 3 – children, from the date of the application, however, rejected the maintenance claim of respondent no.1 – wife.

3. The petitioner preferred Criminal Revision No.218 of 2009, which came to be dismissed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ahmednagar, by order dated 23rd July, 2014. As such present petition.
