1. Heard learned Counsel for the applicants, learned A.G.P. for respondents No.1 and 2 and learned Counsel for respondents - acquiring body.
2. In view of the submissions made by both the sides and the contentions raised in the civil application, I am of the opinion that sufficient cause is shown to condone the delay. However, there will be question of granting interest in respect of the delayed period. Learned Counsel for the original claimants undertakes that the original claimants will not claim interest in respect of this period if the compensation amount is enhanced in the appeal.
3. In the light of above, application is allowed. Delay condoned. The original claimants shall file undertaking to the effect that they will not claim interest in respect of delayed period.
