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PER COURT :-

1. The applicant / original petitioner submits that after the Writ Petition was allowed, under the directions of this Court, an amount of Rs.4,500/- was attempted to be paid to the non-applicant / original respondent. Since he is not traceable, the amount could not be paid.

Voter ID card, on record.
