Heard the learned Counsel appearing for the applicant/appellant and the learned A.P.P. appearing for the respondent – State. Perused the findings recorded by the trial Court and the deposition of the witnesses, which are placed on record by the applicant/appellant.

Upon receipt of the Record and Proceedings, the Sessions Court to prepare the Paper Book and send it to this Court along with the Record and proceedings, as expeditiously as possible, however, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the Record and Proceedings.

5. Liberty to mention for early hearing of the appeal upon receipt of the Paper Book.
