PER COURT:

1 Learned Assistant Government Pleader, appearing for Respondent-State, on instructions, informs that the last date prescribed for admissions to medical course was 30.09.2016 and after the cut-off date, six seats were available. However, since the programme cannot be persuaded further, those seats have lapsed.

2 Learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner controverts the contention and contends that there are certain seats available.

3 The version put up by the State Government is liable to be accepted. Even otherwise, the petitioner, who is placed

at Sr.No.36 in the category of 30% Common Women Quota and at Sr.No.70 in the category of 30% common quota, is not expected to secure admission to the medical course.

4 Petition is devoid of substance. Writ Petition stands dismissed.
