**ORDER :**

1. Petition is filed by revision applicant before the Hon'ble Minister. The proceeding is filed as no order was made on stay application. Learned Counsel for respondent submits that this Court has granted stay and as the present matter is pending in this Court, the Hon'ble Minister is not taking the matter for disposal. She submits that she has no objection if stay is granted for one month and during that period Hon'ble Minister is allowed to dispose of the matter.

2. In view of this submission, the writ petition is disposed of in following terms:

Stay is granted to the order of lower authority for 45 ( forty five ) days as claimed, and within this period, Hon'ble Minister is expected to dispose of the revision application itself. Parties are to appear before the Hon'ble Minister on 05<sup>th</sup> October, 2016. Parties to act on authenticated copies of this order.
