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PER COURT :-

- 1) Heard learned Counsel for the applicants and learned Counsel appearing for Respondent/MSRTC.
- 2) After having read the impugned judgment and after having gone through the grounds of objections raised in memo of appeal, in exception to the impugned judgment, I deem it appropriate to pass the following order, -

ORDER

- i) The applicants are presently permitted to withdraw 40% of the amount on submitting an undertaking that, if any adverse order is passed

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against them in the appeal, they will re-deposit the amount within four months of passing such order;

ii) Balance amount be invested in a Fixed Deposit Receipts in any Nationalized Bank, till disposal of the appeal.

iii) The Civil Application for withdrawal of the amount is disposed of.
