PER COURT:

1. The application is filed by original claimants for permission to withdraw the amount of compensation. Both the sides are heard.
2. Learned counsel for the insurance company submitted that the Award is challenged on many grounds and one of the grounds is contributory negligence of the deceased. Dash was given to the stationary tractor and trolley by motor cycle of the deceased. The Tribunal has granted the compensation amount and nothing is reduced by considering contributory negligence.
