2] The injury certificate would show that there were injuries to the occipital region of one of the injured persons. In the circumstances, it cannot be said that there is no *prima facie* case for trying the present petitioners for the

offences punishable under Section 307, 333, 332, 353, 427, 143, 147, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code; Section 135 of the B.P. Act; and Section 7 of the Criminal Amendment Act.

3] In the circumstances, the impugned order passed by the learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Osmanabad, rejecting the application of present petitioner for discharge, cannot be faulted with.

4] Present Criminal Writ Petition is, therefore, dismissed.
