 3. By this petition, the petitioner seeks following relief :-

“(b) By a suitable writ, order or direction this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to quash and set aside the impugned order of suspension dated 24.02.2014 (Exhibit J) and be pleased to further direct the Respondent No.5 institution to reinstate the petitioner in the post of Head Master at Respondent No.6 Secondary School with full back wages, continuity of services and other consequential benefits”.
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2. The learned counsel appearing for the respondent Nos. 5 and 6 makes a statement that the suspension order issued to petitioner has been withdrawn by respondent Nos. 5 and 6 on 24.4.2014 and

thereafter the petitioner has joined respondent No.6 Secondary School as Head Master. Statement is accepted.

3. In the light of statement made by the learned counsel for the respondent Nos. 5 and 6, relief claimed by the petitioner no more survives. The petition, therefore, stands disposed of.
