2. Heard Mr.Girish Agarwal, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. Vikram Walawalkar, learned counsel for the respondents
3. Mr.Agarwal states that petitioner Ramanlal Devchand Shah is present in the court. He has tendered affidavit dated 2.2.2016 made by the petitioner along with photocopies of Aadhaar card of the petitioner as also identity card issued by Election Commission of India.
