1. At the outset leave to amend is granted so as to correct the number of days of delay. The above Civil Application has been filed to bring the heirs of the Respondent No.1 on record. To the above Civil Application the death certificate of some other person has been erroneously annexed. It is on the said basis that the office has calculated

the delay to be of 4 years and 37 days in filing the application. However, the Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the Respondents on instructions states that the Respondent No.1 has expired on 16.08.2014.
