- 1] Not on board. Upon production, taken on board.
- 2] The challenge in this petition is to the order dated 24 September 2015 made by the Minister (Revenue) granting *ex-parte* “*status quo*”, pending revision instituted by the Respondent No.5.
- 3] Mr. Khandeparkar, learned counsel for the Petitioner, submits that in a matter of this nature there was no question of ordering *status quo* in relation to the property. Upon perusal of the order and the context in which it is made, it is quite clear that *status quo* granted relates to the entry in the revenue record and nothing further. In fact, this is also the understanding of Respondent No.5.

4] However, the statement of the learned AGP to the effect that revision before the Minister (Revenue) itself will be disposed of within a period of three months from today is accepted and directions are also issued to the said effect.

5] The writ petition is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
