- 2 This application is preferred by Insurance Company for condonation of 97 days delay in filing the First Appeal challenging the judgment and award dated 24.8.2011 passed by Commissioner for Workmen's Compensation and Judge, 3rd Labour Court, Mumbai in Application (WCA) No.605/C-195 of 2007.
