The learned Counsel for the Appellant after arguing the Appeal for some time states that it may be clarified that the findings recorded in the impugned order are prima-facie otherwise he apprehends that the learned Judge would be influenced by the disposal of the Appeal treating it as confirmation as the observations made in the impugned order.
