Since the petitioner has not disclosed in full his credential and locus standi to file a public interest litigation and since he practically prays for investigation into the affairs and activities of respondent no.2, and the petitioner has admittedly not made any complaint or representation to any of the authorities concerned, the petition is not required to be entertained.
