1. Heard Mr. Totala, learned Counsel for the petitioner and Mr. Tapkir, learned Counsel for respondent Nos.1 and 2, at length.

By this Petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has challenged the judgment and order dated 18.1.2016 passed by learned 6th Additional Judge, Small Causes Court, Pune below Exh.69 in Civil Suit No.460/2012. By that order, the learned trial Judge allowed the application made by the respondents, hereinafter referred to as the 'plaintiffs' and

exhibited the certified copy of the registered lease deed dated 29.6.2009 and ordered that the same may be read in evidence.
