1 The above Civil Application has been filed seeking condonation of delay of 76 days in filing the above First Appeal. The reasons therefor are mentioned in paragraph 10 of the above Civil Application. The sum and substance of the reasons is that on account of the administrative procedure that is required to be followed in the matter of filing of the above First Appeal that the delay has occasioned.
