2 The grievance of the Petitioner is that though he
had informed the Respondent No. 3 about the theft of the
water by Respondent No. 4, no action appears to have been
taken against him. As directed earlier by this court, a detailed
affidavit in reply has been filed on behalf of the Respondent
Nos. 3 and 4. It is stated that the MIDC is taking appropriate

steps regarding theft of the water and removal of illegal water connections.

3 We are satisfied that the Respondent Nos. 3 and 4 are taking steps for removal of illegal water connections. Liberty is granted to the Petitioner to make a representation for removal of any other illegal water connection and if such representation is made it may be decided in accordance with the law.

4 The Petition is disposed of.
