. By this application, the applicants seek interim protection till their application for anticipatory bail is decided by the learned Judge, Malegaon.

2. The learned Counsel for the applicants states that the learned Sessions Judge, Malegaon has rejected the interim prayer of the applicants and has kept the main application on 22/03/2016.
