Learned counsel appearing for respondent no. 5 - the Bar Council of Maharashtra, on instructions, submits that consequent to the order passed by this court on 6/1/2016, the Bar Council of India disposed of the complaint filed against Advocate Yogesh Dinesh Bhardwaj. Learned counsel further submits that the Bar Council of India has issued direction to remove the name of Yogesh Dinesh Bhardwaj from the Rolls of Bar Council of Maharashtra and Goa. The petitioner, party-in-person,

submits that the complaint filed in the year 2014 was later on registered by the police, but the card of Advocate Yogesh Dinesh Bhardwaj is still being used by other person.
