. After the matter was heard at some length, it is agreed between learned Counsel for the parties that the Petition can be disposed of in terms of the following order.

: O R D E R :

- i) The impugned order of the Industrial Court, Mumbai, dated 24 February 2016 is set aside. The reversion order passed by the first Petitioner bank on 6 January 2016 is also set aside. The Complainant-workmen, who are represented in the present Petition though the Union, shall appear for the typing examination to be conducted by first Petitioner-Bank at the end of four months from today;

- ii) The Petitioner bank shall regularize appointment of concerned workmen in the present post subject to the workmen clearing this test;
- iii) In the event of the workmen not clearing the dues, the first Petitioner shall be at liberty to revert the workmen to their existing post in the subordinate grade.
- iv) All rights and contentions of the parties on merits are kept open;
- v) Complaint (ULP) No.38 of 2016 before the Industrial Court, Mumbai is disposed of in the above terms.
