1. Civil Application 4367 of 2013 is filed for condonation of delay of 292 days in preferring the appeal, which is filed for enhancement of compensation granted by the Tribunal.

2. The learned Counsel appearing for the applicants submits that due to financial problems, they could not meet the legal expenses and hence, could not file the appeal in time.
