Having heard Mr. Kulkarni and finding that in writ jurisdiction it will not be possible for the High Court to direct the respondents to de-notify or de-register respondent no. 3 as a federal society and the petitioner has ample remedies available to it in law so as to seek this relief, this writ petition deserves to be dismissed. We find that even otherwise there is a disputed question raised and particularly about fulfilling of the obligations and duties as a federal society by respondent no. 3. In these

circumstances, by granting the liberty to avail of all alternate and equally efficacious remedies, this writ petition is disposed of.
