2 By this petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India the Petitioner challenges the order dated 29.02.2016 and the decision dated 08.04.2016. The grievance of the petitioner was that the election of the Respondent No.2/Co-operative society was not conducted for last more than one year.

3 The learned Senior Counsel Mr. R.S.Apte appearing on behalf of Respondent No.1 after taking instructions from the Officer appointed by Dy.

Registrar, Co-operative society makes a statement that the authorised officer will complete the process of election of Respondent No.2 within eight weeks from today. Statement is accepted.

4 In view of the statement made by the learned Senior Counsel appearing on behalf of Authorised Officer, nothing survives in the present Writ Petition.

5 Hence, Writ Petition stands disposed of in view of statement of learned Senior Counsel for Respondent No.1.
