Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners on
instructions seeks leave to withdraw the petition. Learned
counsel submits that affidavit in reply is filed by respondent

no.16. Learned counsel has referred the contention raised in paragraph no.1 in the said affidavit which reads as under:
