Mr.Kadam, learned Counsel, having taken instructions from the Petitioner, who is present in the Court, seeks leave to withdraw the petition with liberty (1) to file a protest petition before the concerned Magistrate in respect of Jayesh Ravlekar and Ashok Kashid as report under Section 169, so far as these persons are concerned, prosecution proposes to file, (2) to file an application under Section 216 and / or Section 319 of Cr.P.C., as and when occasion arises.
