. By this application, the applicant seeks condonation of delay of 17 days in filing the present arbitration appeal.

2. I have heard the learned counsel appearing for the respondents and have perused the affidavit filed by the applicant explaining the delay of 17 days. In the affidavit, it was alleged that the Head Office of the applicant at Chennai referred the matter and decided to prefer the appeal. The learned advocate for the applicant is practicing in Mumbai.
