2. In view of the averments made in Paragraphs 5 and 6 of the Application, sufficient cause is made out for condonation of delay of 373 days in preferring the Family Court Appeal. By the impugned decree,

on a Petition filed by the Petitioner husband, the marriage solemnized between the Applicant and the Respondent is dissolved by a decree of divorce.
