- 1] Heard learned counsel for the applicant and learned APP for the State in Criminal Application No. 284 of 2016.
- 2] At the outset, learned counsel for the applicant does not press prayer clause (a). As far as prayer clause (b) is concerned, the applicant seeks extension of eight weeks time to furnish surety, as directed by this Court, vide order dated 18th December, 2015. The applicant vide prayer clause (b) has also sought a direction to the V.P.Road Police Station to carry out the verification process and
